Acquisition of medical and laboratory equipment, consumables, supplies and laboratory reagents
for health facilities and entry points in the Gambia**

The purpose of this Addendum N°1 is to make changes to:

Section III - Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

3. Qualification of Bidders (ITB 37)

3.1 Qualification Criteria (ITB 37.1)

(I) If the Tenderer is the manufacturer:

(i) Financial Capability: Not Applicable.

(ii) Technical skills and experience :

The Bidder shall provide documentary evidence that it meets the following technical capacity and experience requirements. Where the Tenderer is a GECA, previously executed contracts must be in the name of the GECA: Only the experience and demonstrated technical capability of the GECA shall be taken into consideration and not those of individual GECA members or their individual experience/capabilities. The term "Similar Goods", where used, includes upgrades, latest and improved versions or models with similar specifications and technology.

Refer to Form Exp-1 to provide the required information.

(a) The Bidder must have manufactured similar goods since January 1, 2019;

(b) The bidder shall provide written evidence to demonstrate that:

➤ **LOT 1: MEDICAL AND LABORATORY EQUIPMENT FOR STRENGTHENING THE HEALTH SYSTEMS OF THE GAMBIA**

At least two (2) contracts for similar goods have been satisfactorily completed since 1st January 2019, comprising in total for all similar contracts at least the following items and corresponding quantities :

- **Eight (08) oxygen concentrator**
- **Three (03) starter kit for oxygen concentrator**
- **Eight (08) fingertip oximeter**
- **Three (03) macintosh laryngoscope**

➤ **LOT 2: LABORATORY CONSUMABLES AND REAGENTS FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE HEALTH SYSTEMS OF THE GAMBIA**

At least two (2) contracts for similar goods have been satisfactorily executed since January 1, 2019.

The Bidder shall provide the Purchaser with a duly completed EXP-1 Form accompanied by the following documents:

- Acceptance reports;
- Cover and signature pages of executed contracts.

The minimum qualification requirements for several lots (contracts) are the sum of the minimum requirements for the respective individual lots (contracts). It should be noted that the same similar contract may not be considered more than once when bidding for several lots.

(iii) Documentary Evidence of Usage of Goods

The Bidder shall provide written evidence that the Goods it offers meet the following condition(s) of use: The Bidder shall provide the Purchaser with supporting documentation demonstrating to the Purchaser's satisfaction that similar Goods proposed in the bid have been satisfactorily used or operated since January 1, 2019. **If the Bidder is a GECA, evidence of use of previously supplied Goods must be in the name of the GECA.**

(II) If the Bidder is not a manufacturer:

- (ii) Technical capacity and experience:**

The Bidder shall provide documentary evidence that it meets the following technical capacity and experience requirements:

➤ **LOT 2: LABORATORY CONSUMABLES AND REAGENTS FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE HEALTH SYSTEMS OF THE GAMBIA**

At least two (2) contracts for similar goods have been satisfactorily executed since January 1, 2019.

Refer to Form Exp-1 to provide the required information: The Bidder shall provide the Purchaser with the duly completed Form EXP-1 accompanied by the following documents:

- Acceptance reports ;
- Cover and signature pages of executed contracts.

If the Bidder is a GECA, previously executed contracts must be in the name of the GECA: Only the experience and demonstrated technical capability of the GECA will be considered, not those of individual GECA members or their individual experience/capabilities. The term "Similar Goods", where used, includes upgrades, latest and improved versions or models with similar specifications and technology.

The minimum qualification requirements for several lots (contracts) are the sum of the minimum requirements for the respective individual lots (contracts). It should be noted that the same similar contract may not be considered more than once when bidding for several lots.

(III) History of non-performing contracts:

Bidder including manufacturer, if the Bidder is not a manufacturer, and each members of JV in case the Bidder is a JV, shall demonstrate that Non-performance of a contract did not occur as a result of the default of the Bidder, manufacturer or the member of JV as the case may be, since 1st January (specify year). The required information shall be furnished as per form CON-2.

(IV) Pending Litigation:

Financial position and prospective long-term profitability of the Single Bidder, and in the case the Bidder is a JV, of each member of the JV, shall remain sound according to criteria established with respect to Financial Capability under paragraph I (i) above assuming that all pending litigation will be resolved against the Bidder. Bidder shall provide information on pending litigations as per Form CON-2.



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(V) Litigation History:

There shall be no consistent history of court/arbitral award decisions against the Bidder¹ since 1st January 2019. All parties to the contract shall furnish the information as per Form CON-2.
